4. Reconstruction, routine use of free or pedicled grafts, vascularized or non-vascularized, soft and hard tissue. Bone grafts from skull, hip or rib. Jaw joint reconstruction with alloplastic material. Standard flaps following tumor resection including pectoralis major and local flaps. Microvascular trained in Liverpool UK 1988/1989. Undertook the first successful microvascular reconstruction in the Australian Capital Territory 1989

## **Teaching**

From 1984 to 1989 I was involved in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching of dental and medical students and others undertaking higher qualifications.

From 1989 to 2021 an accredited or unaccredited maxillofacial, plastic or ENT surgery registrar has been attached to the different units for training.

In addition, at Macquarie University Hospital from 2010-2017 and when I was The Director of The Maxillofacial Unit there were many Head and Neck fellows, Maxillofacial fellows, Plastic fellows, ENT fellows who all had their specialist qualification but lacked experience and who were attached to my unit for experience. Because I had a large referral base in NSW the Plastic and Maxillofacial surgery unit were able to undertake many head and neck ablative/reconstructive procedures during the 7 years I was involved.

Between 2017-2021 in Albury, I had an unaccredited ENT registrar and accredited general surgery registrar for major maxillofacial and head and neck surgery cases.
